

Look after your mobile!

Chief of Police Howard Reynolds says:

- Keep your mobile in your pocket or your bag.
- 15 • Put it away after each call.
- Never lend it to strangers.
- Use the vibrate alert.
- Use a PIN number so other people can't use your phone.
- 20 • Never argue when people threaten you! Just give them your things.

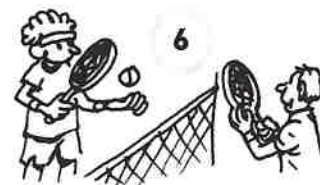

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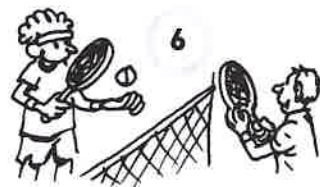

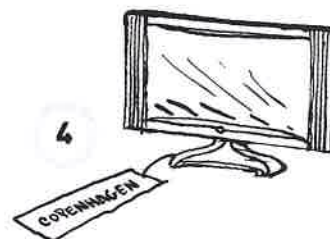
